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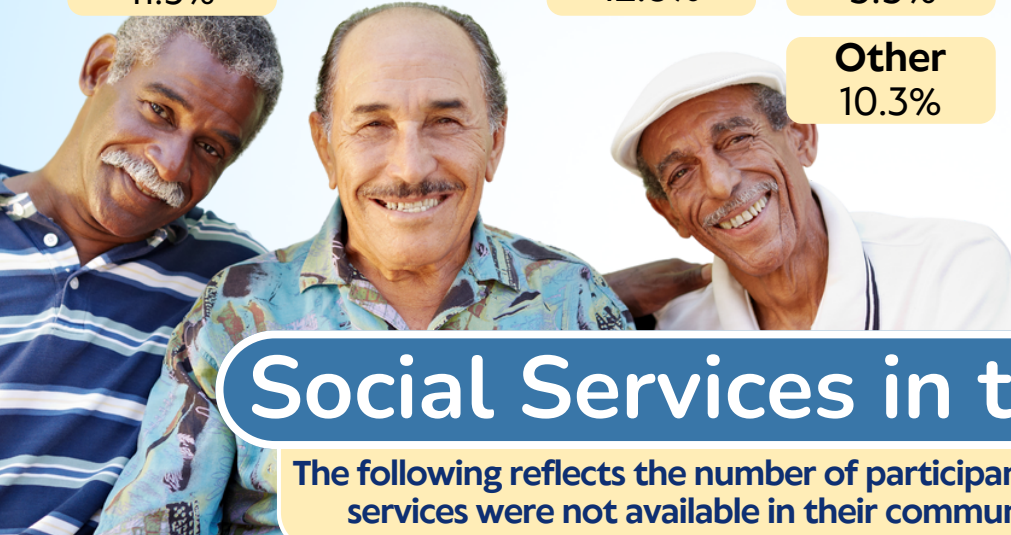

Up to 49% of respondents struggle with the following aspects of living alone:

When asked about programs that were important to their quality of life, participants endorsed:

40.3% Recreation

43.5% Wellness Programs

35.6% Companionship & Social Activities

36.1% Adult Education

24.1% Income Assistance

24.1% Meals Delivered to Home

23.0% In-Home Care & Support
